Dear Landlord:

On October 16, 2013, Congress passed, and the President signed into law, a Continuing Resolution that will fund the government through January 15, 2014. Although the government has reopened, we are still faced with funding cuts as a result of the constraints placed upon us by what is known as sequestration. As a result, the Charlotte Housing Authority (CHA) will continue to be prudent in how we allocate our resources, to ensure that all our landlords are provided with a high level of service.

We understand that the Federal Shutdown led to questions regarding future payments and we are happy to inform you that the CHA's Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program has been assured of its funding through December 2013. This will allow us to continue providing Housing Assistance Payments (HAP) to our landlords on behalf of our HCV participant families.

As always, we shall maintain our promise to maintain open lines of communication at all times, to ensure that you are provided with any latest updates and/or new information pertaining to the Federal Government's budget and how it may impact our operations within the Housing Choice Voucher Program and the CHA.
